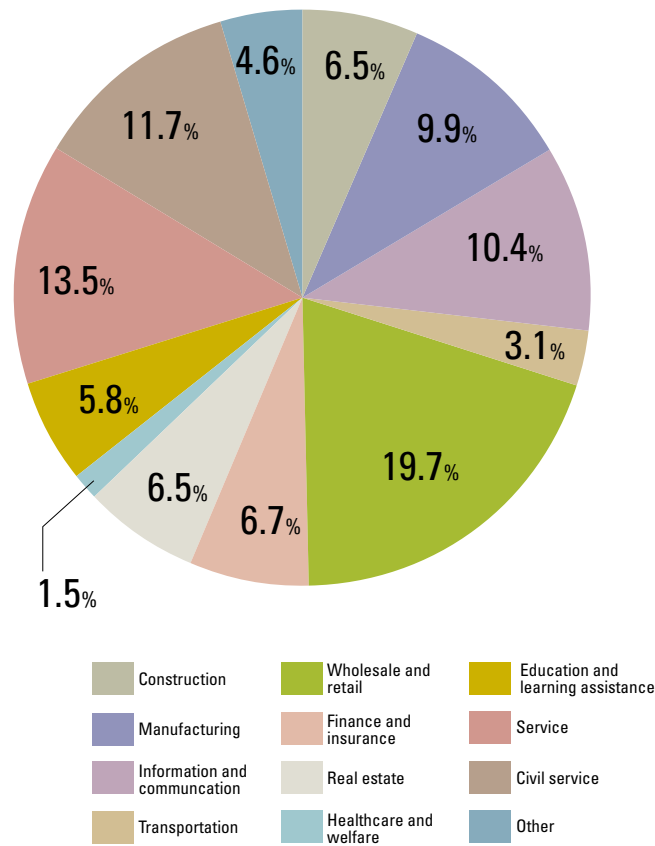

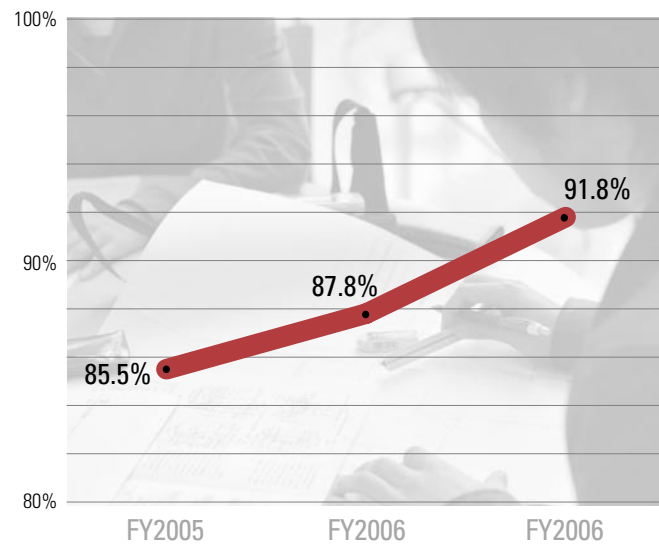

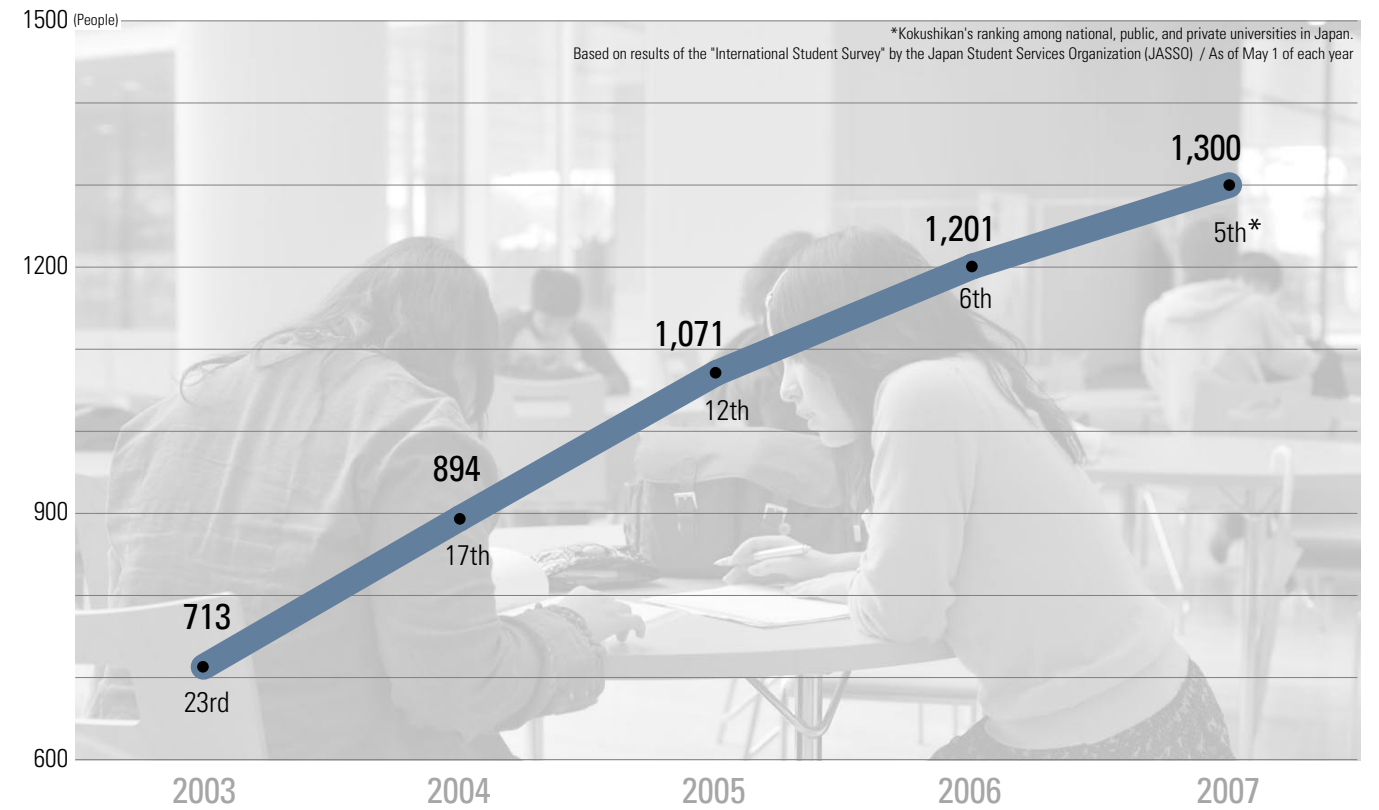
FY2007 Employment, by Industry

The No.1 leading University in student acceptance number for "Career Development Program for Foreign Students from Asia"

Career Development Program for Foreign Students from Asia (Advanced Education Program for Career Development of Foreign Students from Asia) was established by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) in 2007 for exchange students interested in working for a Japanese corporation. From Kokushikan University, 24 students were accepted for the first fiscal year of this project's launch, and 29 students were accepted for FY2008, signifying that the most number of students in the Kanto area were accepted for two years in a row. Accepted persons enter a two-year career support program comprised of four parts, which are business Japanese language training, Japanese business training, internship, and employment assistance.

In FY2007, 149 students from 17 universities (11 public and 6 private) within the jurisdiction of Kanto Bureau of Economy, Trade and Industry were accepted. In FY2008, 171 students from 19 universities (11 public and 8 private) were accepted.
